

Aerosol Generating Procedures (AGP)

Survey Readiness

AGP sign must be posted outside of patient rooms at all times during all AGPs with either 'continuous' checked, or during AGP and one hour afterwards for intermittent AGPs.



For patients with known or suspected respiratory infections OR on Airborne or Droplet isolation, wear a fit-tested N95 and eye protection for AGPs

Aerosol-Generating Procedure (AGP) In Progress

To Enter:



• Staff wear N95 + Eye Protection (or PAPR)



• Visitors and Roommates, wear Standard Mask

Commonly performed medical procedures that ARE considered AGPs:

- *Bronchoscopy*
- *Pulmonary Function Test*
- *Cardiopulmonary resuscitation*
- *Open suctioning of airways*
- *Endotracheal Intubation and Extubation*
- *Sputum induction*
